Location : 200 block MARKET ST	Incident # 10-000040	Officer 0168
Synopsis : Denton Police arrested Kavin Galloway, 21 of Ridgely for controlled dangerous substance (CDS) possession. Police were patrolling the alley behind the 200 block of Market Street when they observed a 1996 Mitsubishi parked, not running, with two occupants. Due to the temperature, approximately 30 degrees, this was suspicious so police approached the vehicle and identified the occupants and inquired as to why they were sitting in the vehicle. During the course of the interview a Denton Police K-9 was deployed to conduct a free air sniff of the exterior of the vehicle for the presence of CDS and the K-9 gave a positive alert. A search of the vehicle led to the seizure of a small quantity of suspected marihuana. Further investigation led to the disclosure that the suspected marihuana belonged to Galloway. Galloway was processed and charged with possession of CDS and taken before a District Court Commissioner for an initial appearance hearing. The Commissioner ordered Galloway released on his personal recognizance after that hearing.

Police stopped a 1998 Mitsubishi for an equipment violation (no tag lights). During the course of the stop a Denton Police K-9 was deployed to conduct a free air sniff of the exterior of the vehicle for the presence of CDS and the K-9 gave a positive alert. A search of the interior of the vehicle revealed evidence that CDs had been consumed in the vehicle but nothing substantial was located. A search of the driver also revealed nothing. A search of the passenger, Enos, led to the seizure of a small plastic straw that contained a white power that police suspected to be cocaine. It is also known that such items are used to inhale various types of CDS through the nose. Enos was issued a criminal citation at the scene and released on his signature of that citation.

Hawkins was issued citations for the traffic and CDS violation and taken into custody on the warrant. Hawkins was the held at the Caroline County Detention Center on that warrant.
