Police attempted to stop a 1995 Mazda for failing to stop at a stop sign, however, when police activated emergency equipment the Mazda accelerated abruptly, turned into a nearby driveway and pulled behind a residence where the Mazda got stuck in the mud. The operator then jumped out of the vehicle where she was detained by police and identified as Silva. Police noted an odor of alcoholic beverage about Silva's breath and person and requested that she submit to a series of standardized field sobriety tests. Based on the results of those tests Silva was taken into custody for suspicion of DUI. During a search of Silva's person, Police located a vile containing suspected marihuana residue. Silva was issued citations for DUI, attempting to flee and elude, negligent driving, failing to stop at a stop sign and possession of CDS paraphernalia. Silva was then released to a responsible person after signing all citations.
