Synopsis : Denton Police charged Maghnum Hastings, 18, and a 17 year old male, both of Denton with possession of a controlled dangerous substance. Police stopped the vehicle for investigative purposes and identified the occupants as Hastings and the 17 year old. During the course of the investigation a Caroline County Sheriff's Office K9 was deployed to conduct an open air sniff of the exterior of the vehicle and the K9 gave a positive response for the presence of CDS. A search of the vehicle led to the seizure of a small amount of suspected marihuana. Both were charged with possession of CDS and possession of CDS paraphernalia. The 17 year old was released to a guardian and Hastings was released on his signature.
