controlled dangerous substance (CDS) offences. Police observed a 2000 Mitsubishi parked in the Pizza Hut parking lot displaying expired registration tabs (10/20009). When police approached the vehicle they detected a very faint odor of burnt marihuana. A Denton Police K9 was deployed to conduct an open air sniff of the exterior of the vehicle and the K9 alerted to the presence of CDS. A search was conducted that led to the seizure of a syringe, a spoon that contained suspected heroin residue and five small plastic bags of a brownish substance that was believed to be heroin on Wiseman's person. Further investigation revealed that the substance was not heroin but was packaged for the intent to sell as heroin. A search of the vehicle led to the seizure of two smoking devices believed to contain marihuana residue. These were determined to belong to Runyon.

Runyon was issued a citation for possession of CDS paraphernalia and released on his signature of that citation.

Wiseman was taken into custody and charged with Fake CDS possession with the intent to distribute, Fake CDS possession, CDS possession - not marihuana and two counts of CDS possession of paraphernalia. Wiseman was ordered held at the Caroline County Detention Center in lieu of \$5,000 bail, 10% acceptable, after an initial appearance hearing before a District Court Commissioner.
