Synopsis : Denton Police are seeking suspect in a serious assault. Police were contacted by staff at Memorial Hospital at Easton who advised that they were treating Will Hall, 29 of Denton, for stab wounds. During the course of the investigation it was learned that Hall and Kevin Antonio Mason, 28 of Ridgely, had been playing video games at Hall's residence. The two left the residence and began to argue about an incident that occurred several months prior. The two then got into a physical altercation which Hall thought was only a fist fight. After a brief period Hall realized that Mason had a knife and that Hall had been injured. Hall was then taken by family members to Memorial Hospital where he was treated for wounds to his upper body and neck. Hall was later transported by Medivac to the Shock Trauma Center in Baltimore for further treatment. Hall was listed as being in stable condition as of 8:40 am on January 15, 2009.		
On July 1, 2010 Mason was extradited from Delaware and was served the charges in reference to this case (first and second degree assault and reckless endangerment). Mason was taken before a District Court Commissioner for initial appearance hearing and was ordered held at the Caroline County Detention Center in lieu of \$15,000 bail.
