Synopsis : Denton Police arrested Donald Lord, 22 of Denton, for assault. Patience Morris, who is Lord's sister, called police and reported that Lord had assaulted her after a verbal altercation. During the altercation Morris alleged that grabbed her, wouldn't allow her to leave the residence and took a cell phone and camera. Police were able to speak with Lord on the stolen phone however he refused to speak with police in person. Based on the above information police applied for charges and received an arrest warrant charging Lord with 2nd degree assault, false imprisonment and theft under \$1000.		
On July 12, 2010 police observed Lord walking on Market Street and took him into custody. Lord was taken before a District Court Commissioner who ordered Lord held at the Caroline County Detention Center in lieu of \$5000 bail.

Synopsis : Denton Police charged Melisa Boyer, 32 of Greensboro, with theft. Synopsis : Denton Police arrested Patrick Baudoin-Rea, 22 of Silver Spring MD, for possession of controlled dangerous substances. Police stopped a 199 Buick for speeding (74 mph in a 55 mph zone). During the course of the traffic stop a Denton Police K9 was deployed to conduct an open air sniff of the exterior of the vehicle and the K9 alerted to the presence of CDS. A search of the vehicle led to the seizure of a small quantity of suspected marihuana, 4 prescription pills and a smoking device that was located in a jacket that belonged to Baudoin-Rea. Baudoin-Rea was charged with (2) two counts of possession of CDS and possession of CDS paraphernalia. Baudoin-Rea was taken before a District Court Commissioner who ordered Baudoin-Rea released on his own recognizance after an initial appearance hearing.
