| Synopsis : Denton Police arrested Jarmar Thomas, 20 of Denton, for assault. Police were contacted by a 17 year old female who advised that Thomas had assaulted her after a verbal altercation. Police observed minor injuries on the victim that were consistent with what was report. | Synopsis : Denton Police responded to a single vehicle motor vehicle collision. On arrival police observed a moped lying in the roadway on Market Street and a male, later identified as the operator of the moped, Sherman Dolby, 68 of Denton, lying in the grass. Investigation revealed that Dolby was attempting to negotiate a turn and rubbed against the curb causing Dolby to lose control of the moped and it crashed. While speaking with Dolby police notice an odor of alcoholic beverage about his breath and person. Dolby was transported to the hospital by EMS for treatment of non life threatening injuries. Police requested that Dolby submit to a blood test for alcohol and Dolby agreed. A check of MVA records revealed that Dolby's privilege to drive was also suspended (a license is required to operate a moped on a public roadway in Maryland). Charges are pending in this matter once the blood test results are obtained. |                      |   |
